

ARE YOU READY?

If you are a state agency, municipality, special district, or other public entity that owns and/or operates one or more sanitary sewer systems, greater than one mile in length, you must comply with the State Water Board's reissued Statewide Sanitary Sewer Systems General Order, Order 2022-0103-DWQ, effective on June 5, 2023.

GENERAL ORDER FOR SANITARY SEWER SYSTEMS

ORDER 2022-0103-DWQ

Existing enrollees of Order 2006-0003-DWQ must certify for continuation of regulatory coverage in CIWQS:

CERTIFY CONTINUATION OF COVERAGE

Existing LROs must certify continuation of coverage in CIWQS

It takes just a few minutes.

If you don't **certify in CIWQS by 11:59 PM Sunday, June 4, 2023**, you will be considered a new enrollee and are required to submit a new application package.

DESIGNATE A LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL (LRO)

By June 4, 2023, enrollees must designate a LRO who:

- Has responsibility for management of the entire sanitary sewer system
- Has authority to make managerial decisions & capital improvement recommendations
- Has or has authority over individuals who possess either:

*A degree or certificate related to sanitary sewer systems operation and maintenance
or*

Extensive knowledge/training related to sanitary sewer system management

UPDATE SPILL EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

Update and implement Spill Emergency Response Plans by June 4, 2023

per Section 5.12, Specifications of the re-issued Order.

Note: Updated Spill Emergency Response Plans do not need to be uploaded into CIWQS.

UPLOAD EXISTING SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN

Upload existing Sewer System Management Plans into CIWQS by June 4, 2023
