Topic: Palo Alto RWQCP Secondary Treatment Upgrades

Over the next several years, the Palo Alto Regional Water Quality Control Plant (RWQCP) will undergo a major upgrade to improve its secondary treatment process. This project will replace the existing trickling filter and activated sludge process with a new biological nutrient removal (BNR) process that includes an innovative membrane aerated biofilm reactor (MABR) system. This presentation will discuss how the City evaluated different options for treatment process upgrades and why the BNR/MABR system was ultimately selected as the path forward to provide the City with an enhanced treatment process that will better protect San Francisco Bay.
