Topic: Partnering: It's not just a process...It's an Attitude!

Partnering requires all parties on a project to set aside their specific contractual obligations and focus on what is required to produce a successful project. These obligations are always there, but the idea of partnering is to work together to identify obstacles that could prove problematic for the project and mitigate these obstacles with innovative and creative solutions. These solutions may not be evident to any one party, but when all parties work collaboratively, they find solutions that work for everyone. Two specific case studies will be presented. The Foster City Levee Improvements project constructed a new 6.5-mile-long outboard levee to protect the City and its residents from sea level rise. The second project will focus on the Gravity Pipeline project, part of the \$500M RESCU program at Silicon Valley Clean Water in Redwood City.
