Features of the EBMUD WWTP

Since 1951, EBMUD has provided wastewater treatment services at the Main Wastewater Treatment Plant to protect public health and the San Francisco Bay. EBMUD's 88-square-mile wastewater service area is home to 740,000 people who live in Alameda, Albany, Berkeley, El Cerrito, Emeryville, Kensington, Oakland, Piedmont, and parts of Richmond. EBMUD started secondary treatment in 1978, onsite power generation in 1985, the Resource Recovery (R2) program (i.e., co-digestion) in 2002, and the East Bayshore Recycled Water project in 2008.

This tour will provide an overview of EBMUD's Main Wastewater Treatment Plant, including a walk-through of preliminary treatment, primary treatment, secondary treatment, wet weather storage, anaerobic digestion, high-strength waste receiving, and power generation. Some notable achievements at the MWWTP include 1) in 2012, EBMUD MWWTP became the first WWTP in North America to produce more renewable energy onsite than needed to run the facility, and 2) since 2020, EBMUD has utilized existing high purity oxygen activated sludge (HPOAS) for full-scale biological nutrient removal to maximize nitrogen removal during the dry season.
