INTRODUCTION

The Oro Loma Sanitary District provides wastewater treatment and disposal services for approximately 135,000 residents across San Lorenzo, Castro Valley, parts of San Leandro, and Hayward. The district serves 47,103 accounts, with 97.3% residential and the remainder commercial, industrial, or significant industrial users.

The facility operates using primary and secondary treatment processes to remove solids and organic matter. Treated effluent is disinfected before discharge. Remarkably, the plant is energy self-sufficient, utilizing methane gas and solar energy to power its operations and ensure environmental sustainability.
