The **Student Design Competition** promotes real world design experience for students interested in pursuing an education and/or career in water/wastewater engineering and sciences. It tasks individuals or teams of students within a WEF student chapter to prepare a design to help solve a local water quality issue. Teams evaluate alternatives, perform calculations, and recommend the most practical solution based on experience, economics, and feasibility.

CWEA will award a team of college students financial assistance for travel expenses up to \$8,500 per team (if sending 5 people) or \$2,000 per person (if sending 4 or less).

The abstract (brief summary of the design), not to exceed 200 words must be submitted to CWEA by **March 4**.

Include:

- The project name
- University name (team name)
- Advisor's name

Entrant's names shall also be included with submission but will not count towards the 200 word limit.
